Superintendent's Report: State Aid Update: Superintendent Dougherty spoke on the passage of the NYS Budget and what is known and still unknown regarding the federal government funding to the State. Discussions followed on the government funding and guidance, final cost report, fund balance projection(s) and tax levy. Staffing for 2021-2022: The District is currently looking to fill four (4) positions (one of which is 0.5 FTE) due to retirements. Classroom Distancing: Guidance from NYS Health Department was provided earlier in the day regarding the 3' distancing in classrooms. An addendum will be added to the existing plan, and Administration will obtain input from staff. Mr. Schaffer, Middle School Principal stated that Grade 6 will begin full-day, in-person classes on April 19, 2021. Discussions followed. Regents Exams: The federal government is requiring 4 out of the 10 Regents Exams are to be offered this school year. Discussions followed (i.e., requirements, in-person vs remote learning students, exemptions, etc.). Year-End Guidance: Guidance was received this afternoon, and it appears there will be more flexibility. The District's goal is to have one (1) outdoor graduation for all Seniors, prom is currently being discussed, and a Senior Trip is in the works for a place that is local and small and done in a way with social distancing parameters. Snapshots of Success: Superintendent Dougherty stated that the highlight for him has been watching kids compete again. They've been very resilient and have done a nice job transitioning. It was noted that spectators (home and visitors) have been respectful of what the District (and other districts as well) have had to do. Discussions followed.
