**Superintendent's Report: Opening of School Year:** Superintendent Dougherty provided the latest information on mask mandates from the Governor and NYS Department of Health. The mandate requires all Pre-K through 12 students, staff and visitors to wear masks while inside a school building. Discussions followed on indoors vs. outdoors, social distancing, the 90-day window of said mandate (renew, modify, eliminate), etc. Superintendent Dougherty is expecting further operational guidance later in the week. **Capital Project:** Superintendent Dougherty and Gary Hoskins recently met with Paul Bedford and Gene Hulbert to discuss capital projects. The Board will receive a scope of the projects for review. The largest portion of the project will be roofing, followed by blacktopping throughout the District. Discussions followed (i.e., removing lockers from the basement, a fieldhouse, etc.). **Summer Recap:** Mr. Rodgers, Elementary School Principal, reported on the summer program offered at Nathan T. Hall Elementary. The 3-week program offered fun enrichment classes along with reading, writing and math. There were approximately 150 students. Meals were provided. Discussions followed. Mr. Schaffer, Middle School Principal, reported there were approximately 60 students who attended the MS program designed for those who had struggled throughout the 2020-2021 school year. Additionally, there were 100 students who participated in the enrichment programs. Mr. Schaffer stated that 18 Grade 5 students participated in the CTE Summer Program at BOCES. Heidi Cardone, Summer Rec Program Director, reported there were 89 registered students for the Summer Rec Program with a daily average of 50 students. Ms. Cardone noted that transportation as well as 225 daily meals were provided for the summer school programs and the Summer Rec Program. Discussions followed. Mr. Asfoury, High School Principal, reported 11 out of the 28 Grade 8 students who had trouble passing classes during the 2020-2021 school year attended summer school. These project-based classes were held Monday through Thursday for three (3) weeks and allowed students to catch up. Additionally, students in grades 9 through 12 were also able to attend summer school for credit recovery and new credit. Discussions followed.

**Board Matters:**
