## MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION NEWARK VALLEY CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT December 12, 2016

The Newark Valley Central School District Board of Education met in regular session at 6:30 p.m. James Phillips led the Pledge of Allegiance. The following Board Members were in attendance: Randal H. Kerr, James Phillips, Thomas Darpino, Anthony D. Tavelli, Ralph Parmelee, Susan Watson and Sarah Hines. <u>Presentation:</u> Athletic Update-Ed Mertson, Athletic Director, provided updates/highlights on the Fall athletic programs, sports participation rate for grades 7-12 (48%), overall GPA for teams (84 or better). Upcoming Winter sports were briefly discussed. Discussions followed on the continued focus of academics, scholarships, competitiveness, athletics impacting the school, coaching/coaches, evaluations, etc.

Superintendent's Report: Superintendent Dougherty spoke on the following: CSO recently met with the NYSCOSS Executive Director, their Chief Legal Counsel as well as their Chief Lobbyist. Discussions centered around: the direction of federal school financing (it's anticipated that the majority of funding will go to Medicaid and Corrections), petroleum price increases and impacts on school districts; upcoming retirements of NYS superintendents and possible impacts, education policy and the "state of being" within the Board of Regents, CFE's, etc.; New ESSA Foster Care Regulations: As part of the No Child Left Behind Law, a new clause goes into effect where it is assumed the best place for a foster child is to remain in his/her current school district when being placed outside of the district. Superintendent Dougherty is co-authoring a transportation procedure with Tioga County DSS. Discussion followed on scenarios, impact to the District, etc. Meeting with Senator Akshar: Seven area superintendents will be meeting with Senator Akshar to discuss State Aid, teacher shortages, where the Senate is going on education, making State mandates and funding of those mandates (establishment of sunset rules and an evaluation process) Snap Shots of Success: Mr. Dougherty stated the performances at the Middle and High School Holiday Concerts were outstanding. It was noted that student participation has increased in instrumental music at the Middle School, Mr. Nave was recognized for a job well done.
