Superintendent's Report: COVID Update: There are currently 19 staff and 70+ students who are under a mandated quarantine at the High School. Of the 19 staff members, 8 will be able to return on December 15, 2020. At this time, there are no substitutes available, which is not unique. December 21, 2020 is the tentative date in which the High School will return to the hybrid model. It is the District's commitment to have students in attendance every day. Superintendent Dougherty stated students, parents and teachers are doing a great job. Discussions followed (i.e., case numbers, contact tracing, etc.). Second Semester Preparations: Mr. Schaffer touched on second semester preparations. A survey, similar to the survey sent out before school started in September, will be rolled out on December 16, 2020. Transportation will be the hardest. There will be a significant amount of work to be done in January 2021. Five (5) different models are currently being reviewed. Discussions followed. Five (5) Year Plan: Superintendent Dougherty stated that discussions will start taking place in February with a series of meetings to be held. A draft plan will be provided to the Board for feedback. It is expected that the plan be completed and in place by 2025. Discussions followed. Snapshots of Success: Superintendent Dougherty thanked all staff for being so flexible and pulling in the same direction.
