The Newark Valley Central School District Board of Education met in regular session at 5:31 p.m. Susan Watson led the Pledge of Allegiance. Superintendent's Report: Superintendent Dougherty spoke on: 2022 Legislative Breakfast: A planning meeting was held last week. It was noted that some issues are carryovers from previous years. Discussions followed (i.e., main topics). Rapidly Changing COVID Guidelines: CSO met last week to sort through guideline changes (i.e., time reduction in quarantine days, contact tracing being less onerous, etc.). Discussions followed. Administration Updates: Superintendent Dougherty stated that the Administration restructure is progressing smoothly and staff has met. Auditors from the State Comptroller's Office remain in the District. However, no items have been identified at this time. Additionally, Mr. Dougherty will provide the Board with the requested instructional information used for students who are quarantined. Discussions followed. High School Principal Report: Mr. Asfoury, High School Principal, reported: 1) the High School is sustaining day-today even with everyday challenges; 2) 87% of classes are being passed at the 15 week mark; 3) there is currently a 92% attendance rate; 4) there are 19 extracurricular groups with 241 students participating (61% participation rate); 5) NYS has cancelled the January 2022 Regents exams; and 6) the computer-based testing simulations for Grade 8 NYS English and Math exams will be on January 12, 2022. Additionally, Mr. Asfoury spoke on student opportunities and the upcoming musical by the Valley Masquers. Discussions followed. Snapshots of Success: Superintendent Dougherty commended the Building Secretaries for their continued efforts in keeping the school open and finding coverage for staff.
