An individual who can interpret the instructional implications of evaluation results, provided that such individual may also be the individual appointed as the regular education teacher, the special education teacher or special education provider, the school psychologist, the representative of the school district or a person having knowledge or special expertise regarding the student when such member is determined by the school district to have the knowledge and expertise to fulfill this role on the committee.
- 7. A school physician, if specifically requested in writing by the parent of the student or by a member of the school at least 72 hours prior to the meeting.
- 8. An additional parent member of a child with a disability residing in the school district or a neighboring school district, provided that such parent may be the parent of a student who has been declassified within a period not to exceed five years or the parent of a student who has graduated within a period not to exceed five years. Such parent is not a required member if the parent(s) of the child request that the additional parent member not participate - Karen Umiker (Alternate - Toni Dean).

9. Other persons having knowledge or special expertise regarding the child, including related services personnel as appropriate, as the school district or the parents shall designate. The determination of knowledge or special expertise of such person shall be made by the party (parents or school district) who invited the individual to be a member of the committee on special education.
