# MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION NEWARK VALLEY CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT June 15, 2020

THIS MEETING WAS HELD DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC. BY AN EXECUTIVE ORDER ISSUED BY THE GOVERNOR ON MARCH 13, 2020, A PORTION OF THE OPEN MEETINGS LAW WAS WAIVED. SPECIFICALLY:

"Article 7 of the Public Officers Law, to the extent necessary to permit any public body to meet and take such actions authorized by the law without permitting in public in-person access to meetings and authorizing such meetings to be held remotely by conference call or similar service, provided that the public has the ability to view or listen to such proceeding and that such meetings are recorded and later transcribed."

The Newark Valley Central School District Board of Education met in regular session at 3:02 p.m. in the District Office located within the High School. The general public was only able to view said meeting via webcam for a short period due to YouTube Live errors. The stream was ultimately terminated due to the errors. Extended School Year for Special Education: An executive order has been issued for extending the school year for special education students. As BT BOCES is not prepared to provide this service, Jami Fabrizio, Director of Special Education, has a good plan for providing services remotely. An application was submitted to NYSED today.
