APPR-hardship waiver submitted; discussed teacher appeals process; negotiations continues with administration and teachers. Social Work Interns-may host interns from BU; currently working on details. Agriculture/Environmental Science Program-will take approximately 18 months to building this program; working with Cornell; discussion followed on Alexander Pond, utilization of the District's sound science teachers, community resources, funding, baseline curriculum, etc. Snap-shots of Success: With regard to The Nest, Superintendent Dougherty was recently in the library and found that the students were engaged, respectful and all areas were clean.
