MINUTES

Superintendent's Report: Robert Rodgers presented the Elementary School Report. Mr. Rodgers highlighted the following: regional gains in math (5th out of 15) and ELA (3rd out of 15), new data tracking procedure, alignment of the common core, modifications of assessments, adjustments and implementation of ELA modules, implementation of 45 minute writing block and guided reading and skills work. Discussion followed. Superintendent Dougherty stated he is looking at a possible \$7.00/day differential in Substitute Teachers and Substitute Nurses' pay. Discussion followed on the annual substitute usage. Mr. Dougherty stated he will be involved in a transportation facility meeting next week with Gary Hoskins, Randy Zukowski, the District's legal counsel, the Village of Newark Valley and the village's legal counsel. He will report back at the next Board Meeting. Mr. Dougherty stated the \$2B Smart Schools Bond Act passed. As of yet, there is no guidance from NYS. In broad terms, districts will be able to: build out the IT infrastructure, upgrade security, build out the Pre-K infrastructure and replace classroom trailers with permanent instructional space. Snapshots of Success: Superintendent Dougherty stated the football players played well this year. They maintained confidence and pride throughout the season and into playoffs. Additionally, varsity cross country participants ran well this year. It's extraordinary to have 8th graders qualify and run at States. Good job to all athletes!
