# MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION NEWARK VALLEY CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT November 13, 2017

The Newark Valley Central School District Board of Education met in regular session at 6:30 p.m. James Phillips led the Pledge of Allegiance. The following Board Members were in attendance: Randal Kerr, James Phillips, Thomas Darpino, Susan Watson, Anthony Tavelli and Ralph Parmelee. Board Member Sarah Hines was absent. The following school personnel were in attendance: Ryan Dougherty, Ji Katchuk, Phyllis Kaufman, Scott Wandell, Renee Callahan and Tina Engelhard. There was 1 guest.

Presentation: Scott Wandell, Athletic Director, provided a recap on Newark Valley's Fall athletics and upcoming events: Bob Greene Invitational-event ran smoothly with 20+ teams in attendance; Homecoming was a success and well attended by alumni; student athletes participated in the Replace The Lace shoelaces which were being sold to support Brody Hines (\$2,000 was raised); Field Hockey teams have a full squad and came into their own towards the end of season; the Varsity Football student athletes and coaches were commended and congratulated on their season; Varsity Girls Cross Country were commended and congratulated on being this year's NYS State Champions; coaches' evaluations are currently underway; the Athletic Department is building a comprehensive system for uniforms (tracking, condition, etc.); impact testing (concussions) is underway - discussions followed on program, athletic trainer, etc.; an Ithaca College Sports Psychologist will be the speaker at this year's Winter Sports Captains' Dinner; NV will be hosting: the Larry Goodrich Tournament on 12/2/17, the IAC Wrestling Tournament, and possibly the Cheerleading competition; Long-term projects were discussed (coaches' handbook, banners, online scheduling/software); Discussions followed on participation and youth community teams.

Superintendent's Report: Superintendent Dougherty spoke on: Ski Club—Superintendent Dougherty was approached by William Knight (community member) inquiring about restoring the club within the District. A survey had been conducted and approximately 50 students responded positively to participation. Discussions followed. This will be presented again at a future meeting. School Start Time—The Leadership Team is in the early discussion phase. Discussions followed on having complete uniformity, adding to the Exit Poll questions, etc. NYSCOSS Fiscal Outlook #1—News has come from the Comptroller's office. A mid-year budget was established on November 10, 2017 where it appears there will be a \$4.4B deficit. Discussions followed on State aid anticipations, previous aid years, etc. Property Update—Two of the three gas leases have been released, title searches and abstracts are running smoothly. Snap Shots of Success — Superintendent Dougherty congratulated Renee Riegel for being ESPN Ithaca's Athlete of the Week; student and teacher participants of the production Annie were recognized
