Superintendent's Report: Executive Principal, Todd Schaffer reported on Superintendent Dougherty's behalf. **SRO Update:** The District continues to move forward, and the contract is nearly finalized. Discussions followed on campus resource philosophy (staff, students, parents), liaison with local police, proactive presence, etc. Discussions followed. **Update on Centralized Attendance:** Cassandra Kaczmarek started last week. She trained four out of the five days and is now working closely with Val Murtha. **Middle School Report:** Mr. Schaffer provided Building-Wide Highlights: Student Council is having a food drive with Project Neighbor being the recipient, band and chorus concerts are starting back up after 1.5 years with 50-60 kids per grade level participating, afterschool enrichment and academic assistance programs meet twice a week with two teachers per grade level involved. Grade-Level highlights: Grade 4 – pathways/focused academics – learning to be students again and building a community; Grade 5 – project based – learning different themes each month and presenting projects; Grade 6 – choice words – different levels of rigor; and Grade 7 – team building. 
