Presentation: External Audit Report: Ms. Leslie Spurgin, Insero & Co. CPAs, LLP provided a summary of the External Audit Report. The July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022 Educational Stabilization Funds (CARES Act) and Extra Classroom Activity Funds were audited. Ms. Spurgin noted that this was a good audit year with the highest level of assurance. Discussions followed. Capital Project: Mr. Paul L. Bedford, Keystone Associates, Architects, Engineers and Surveyors, LLC presented additional information on the Proposed Capital Project Referendum Scope of Work. Two (2) proposed plans were presented. The timing/scheduling of the referendum, design and SED were outlined. Superintendent's Report: NCern Update: Interim Superintendent Schaffer stated the research group is mid-program and is focusing on post-secondary readiness. The group involves small rural New York and Ohio schools working with Harvard and Cornell. Discussions followed. APPR Update: Interim Superintendent Schaffer stated New York State is restarting APPR and will only be looking at last year's data. The rollout will be January 2023. Discussions followed (i.e., testing). Snap Shots of Success: Varsity Girls' Soccer will be competing at Sectionals. PSAT costs are now being covered by the District. There are 45 students signed up to take the test.

Instruction: Mr. Robert Rodgers, Elementary School Principal, stated there are 320 students enrolled at Nathan T. Hall Elementary School for the 2022-2023 school year. There are 45 Pre-K students with 10 of those students being 3 years old. Mr. Rodgers stated things are back to normal in the building and assessments are complete. New programs this school year are Phonemics, Phonics, Intervention & Acceleration and 7 Habits.
