Capital Project Development: Superintendent Dougherty spoke on the first rendition of the capital project: building of a field house, concession stand, bathrooms, extra storage and removal of lockers in the HS basement. The project will also include a substantial amount of roofing and blacktopping. Additionally, the District is in the early stages/ discussions for lights on the football field as well as the soccer fields. Discussions followed (i.e., field house location, roofing warranty, etc.). Director of Data & Instructional Progress Update: Ms. Valerie Murtha provided a data component overview - every student learning every day, COVID reporting, digital access and hardware and software access. For the curriculum component, Ms. Murtha stated that Nathan T. Hall Elementary and the Middle School teachers spent time over the summer on K-7 ELA. Discussions followed.
