### PROPOSITION NO. 3

Shall the capital reserve fund approved by the voters of the school district on May 12, 1993 under the provisions of Education Law 3651 be amended as follows: The purpose of the fund shall be to purchase, in whole or in part, school district vehicles, which would include school buses, from time to time with voter authorization. The probable term of the reserve fund shall be for twenty years from the date of this amendment. The ultimate amount of the reserve fund shall not exceed \$10,000,000. The source of funding of the reserve fund shall be any or all of the following: unappropriated fund balances from the general fund as determined by the Board of Education, state aid related to expenditures made from the reserve fund for the purchase of vehicles, insurance or liability recoveries associated with the loss of vehicles, proceeds from the sale of vehicles, as well as interest income related to the monies in the fund?
